A quirky and charming 2 bedroom 2 bathroom terraced townhouse with a build of 110m² located within easy walking distance of the market square in the very heart of Turre which offers a labyrinth of streets in the old town with tapas bars. In the main square there is a natural fountain supplying drinking water to visitors all year round. The main area offers a variety of shops, bars and restaurants and Friday's have the very popular market day.

As mentioned previously, the property is located a very short walk away from Turre market square and is set in a pedestrian street. A door from the street leads into the a lovely entrance hall /dining area with lovely stone arches opening into the living room boasting original features, including a wood burning stove and stone inlaid into the wall.

Off the living room there is a fully fitted kitchen with access onto a very private internal courtyard/patio with mosaic wall designs which is home to a bar area, the 2nd bathroom with shower and a utility/storage area. From here, stairs lead up to the private terrace with views overlooking the village, a shaded area for lounging and a large storeroom.

Back from the living room to the right is the first of the 2 double bedrooms which is a very generous size. A set of stairs from the living room then leads up to the master bedroom which is a good size and boasts a walk-in wardrobe, air conditioning and en-suite bathroom.

Many of the ceilings have exposed beams, and some of the internal walls have features of natural stone.

Turre is situated only an hours drive from Almeria international airport and 2 to 2.5 hour drive to the airports of Murcia and Alicante and has excellent motorway access.

The property has many original features and has been renovated to a good standard, whilst maintaining many original features, such as exposed wooden beams and stone walls.
